

BOBSLEIGH CANADA SKELETON 2019-20 NATIONAL TEAM ATHLETE MEMBERSHIP FEE

In addition to agreeing to the terms of and signing the **2019-20 Bobsleigh CANADA Skeleton (BCS) Athlete Agreement** ("2019-20 Athlete Agreement") and fulfilling any other requirements as may be notified from time to time, all current National Team (National Bobsleigh Program (NBP) and National Skeleton Program (NSP)) Athletes renewing their National Team Athlete status are assessed the following National Team Athlete Membership Fee (NTAMF) in accordance with the 2019-20 Athlete Agreement:

A. NTAMF

- i. The **NTAMF** of **\$260** is due and payable in full by ***June 28th, 2019.***

The NTAMF shall be used to cover costs relating to:

1. BCS Class B Membership;
2. CAIP – Bronze Level* coverage; and/or
3. IBSF e-license registration.

**Athletes may choose to upgrade to Silver or Gold Level for an additional \$230 or \$560 (plus any applicable taxes) respectively. This must be done at the time of enrollment. If you are currently enrolled in the CAIP you cannot make changes or upgrade until your annual renewal date. B. NTAMF Payment

- i. Fees may be paid by cash, cheque, Interac e-Transfer, or credit card** (Mastercard or VISA)

***Athletes who choose to pay their fees by credit card (Mastercard or VISA) will be charged back the credit card processing surcharge as follows:*

- 2.65%** on CC charges processed in person (card swiped); or
3.40% on CC charges processed manually (via phone, email, etc.).*

C. NTAMF Terms

- i. An Athlete who fails to pay the NTAMF shall cease to be a "member in good standing" of BCS, with all associated consequences, including but not limited to exposing the Athlete to disciplinary action.
- ii. For the avoidance of doubt:
 1. No Athlete shall be eligible for the Sport Canada AAP, to participate in BCS National Team camps and/or events, travel, compete and/or receive other benefits from BCS without paying the NTAMF;
 2. Non-current National Team athletes who are selected to a National Team following the respective 2019-20 selection processes will also be assessed the NTAMF; and
 3. The NTAMF is non-refundable.

D. Other Fees

- i. BCS may, from time to time, assess other fees in relation to Athlete activities and programming, including but not limited to an Athlete Program Fee (APF).
