

## **APPENDIX A – NSP AAP RANKING SYSTEM**

The NSP AAP Ranking System utilizes the combination of a **Competition Score** and a **Selection Score**, as applicable, in order to rank NSP Athletes within the Carding Level Priority for the purposes of nominations to the AAP.

### **1. COMPETITION SCORE**

The Competition Score is calculated based off the athletes’ 2021-22 Season results using their WCh/OWG results and the points achieved from their highest single scoring IBSF race, adjusted relative to the competitive field in each race and/or discipline, as per **Table 1**.

The **Adjusted WCh/OWG Relative Rank (A)** is based on the athlete’s result in the specified WCh/OWG competition, relative to the competitive field, by discipline. The number of WCh/OWG Competitors is considered to be the total number of athletes who were ranked in the race.

The **Adjusted IBSF Overall Relative Rank (B)** is based on the athlete’s IBSF Overall Rank in the specified season, relative to the number of athletes on the specified ranking list by discipline. The number of IBSF Overall Competitors is considered to be the total number of athletes who appear on the IBSF Overall Ranking summary, by discipline, with a point total greater than zero.

The Competition Score (I) is the sum total points of A and B.

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### **2. SELECTION SCORE**

Points, as per **Table 2**, are assigned to each athlete based on their respective APE score (C), the team to which they have been selected to (D), if they achieved the NSP Push Standard (E), if they achieved the NSP Sprint Standard (F) and if they achieved the NextGen Skeleton Athlete (NGSA) designation (G).

The Selection Score (II) is the sum total points of (C, D, E, F and G) divided by a factor of 10.

### **3. NSP AAP RANKING**

Within each Carding Level Priority, athletes are ranked, whereby the athlete with the greatest point total ranks the highest, referred to as the NSP AAP Ranking, based on the following:

- a) for the purposes of Pre-season Carding Cycle nominations, according to the Competition Score (I); and
- b) for the purposes of In-season Carding Cycle nominations, according to the sum total of the Competition Score (I) and Selection Score (II), as applicable.

In the event of a tie in NSP AAP Ranking, the tie will be broken by the respective athlete's most recent APE Score, with the higher APE score deemed to be ranked higher.

**Table 3** provides an example of the NSP AAP Ranking System and corresponding calculations.

**Tables 4** and **5** provide examples of the resulting NSP AAP Nominations and Allocations for the Pre-Season and In-Season Carding Cycles respectively.
