Bobsleigh CANADA Skeleton (**BCS**) is the national governing body for the sports of bobsleigh and skeleton in Canada. As one of Canada's most successful Winter Olympic sports, our program is based upon a platform of strong strategic and performance planning, teamwork and the relentless pursuit of excellence.

In alignment with our Mission, Vision and Values, Bobsleigh CANADA Skeleton is searching for a National Bobsleigh Program Sled Mechanic (**NBP-SM**), in order to support our NBP athletes to podium performances in Beijing at the 2022 Olympic Winter Games.

Primary Purpose:

In consultation with program staff and while working under the authority and direction of the High Performance Director (**HPD**) and/or NBP Head Coach (**NBP-HC**), ensure that BCS bobsleighs are well maintained, optimally prepared for all training and competition and to ensure that BCS's equipment and tools are well maintained. This refers to working with the NBP athletes in preparation for training and competitions on the IBSF circuits and any other competition and/or training as directed.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Travel to Calgary, Whistler and/or other locations during the off-season, as required by the HPD, to maintain, repair and/or modify bobsleighs in a timely manner in preparation for in-season training and competition;
- Travel with the NBP to training and competitions to maintain, modify, repair and race prepare BCS bobsleighs ensuring they adhere to current IBSF rules;
- Working with the NBP-HC to prepare required reports and evaluations of BCS Bobsleighs, equipment and tools; and
- Attend all strategic, logistical or performance related meetings or events as required.

The ideal candidate will have experience working with composites, carbon fibre and glass fibre along with operating metal working and welding machinery. They should be a strong team player who possesses excellent communication skills and is able to address the technical needs of the NBP.

The nature of the position demands flexible hours until work is completed to meet the requirements. This includes but is not limited to working extended hours, evenings and weekends, particularly in-season and during off-season time frames as well as significant international travel periods.
