In alignment with our Mission, Vision and Values, Bobsleigh CANADA Skeleton is searching for a National Skeleton Program Technical Lead / Head Coach (**NSP-TL/HC**), in order to support our National Skeleton Program (**NSP**) & National Development Skeleton Program (**NDSP**), to podium performances in Milano-Cortina at the 2026 Olympic Winter Games and beyond.

Primary Purpose:

In consultation with program staff and while working under the authority and direction of the High Performance Management Group (**HPMG**), the successful candidate will be responsible for the planning, coordination, integration, delivery, coaching, and evaluation of the NSP for Bobsleigh CANADA Skeleton. This refers to working with the NSP and/or NDSP athletes in preparation for training and competitions on the IBSF circuits and any other competition and/or training as directed by the HPD.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Competition strategy, equipment development and management, athlete development and program planning and administration;
- Planning, logistics, budgeting, delivery and evaluation of all technical aspects at training, competition and camp venues internationally;
- Providing expert coaching, advice, guidance and feedback to NSP and NDSP athletes (in collaboration with other BCS staff, as appropriate) in the areas of on-ice technical driving and elite performance requirements (in general);
- Prepare required reports, including: mid- and end of season evaluations, weekly competition reports, evaluations and reviews; and
- Attend all strategic, logistical or performance related meetings or events as required.

The ideal candidate will be a technically strong team player with coaching and team management experience at the World Cup, World Championships and Olympic levels who possesses excellent communication skills and is able to address the technical needs of the Programs, within the overall goals of BCS.

The NSP-TL/HC position is based in Calgary and the nature of the position demands flexible hours which includes but is not limited to working extended hours, evenings and weekends, particularly in-season and during off-season camps, as well as significant international travel periods.
